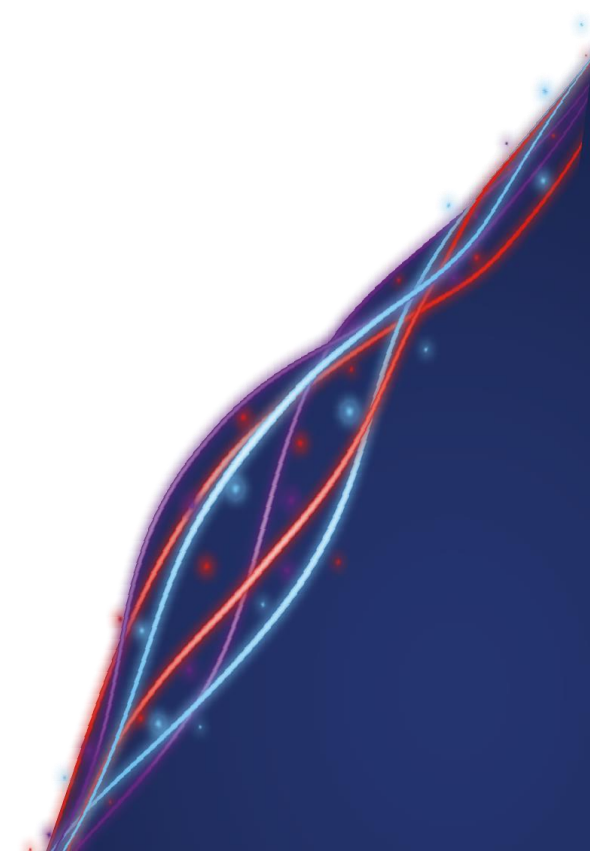

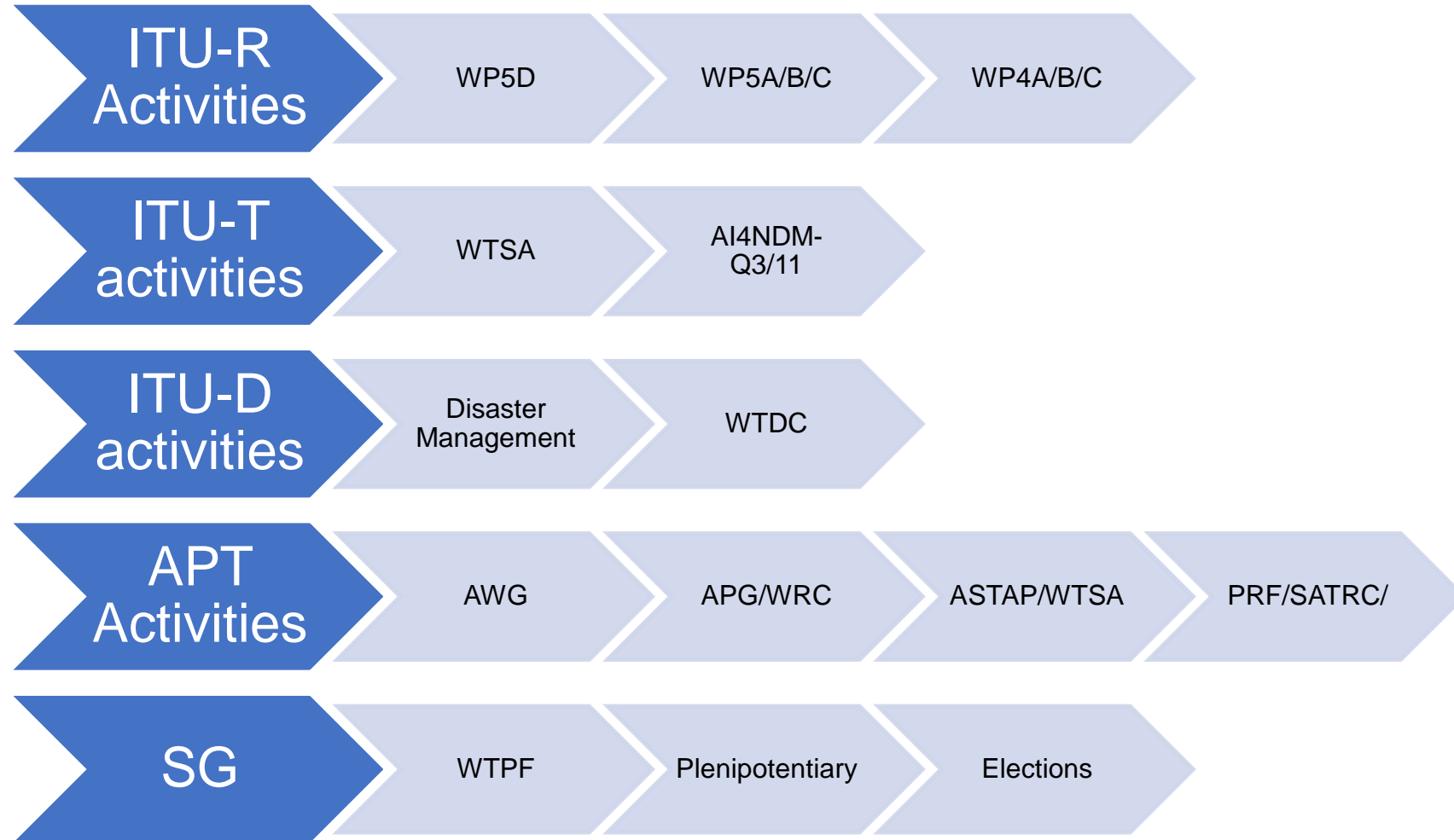

"In the previously failed auctions of 700 MHz, the average reserve price for the auction in 700 MHz in Feb 2021 was about \$1.89 per MHz per p (adjusted for PPP) which is 34 times higher than that set International (\$0.05) and is also higher than the mean winning bid price witnessed worldwide (\$0.54)" IAFI stressed in its submission.
